THE MEN WHO SAVED A PRESIDENT

Black people can be found in different parts of the world. One part of the world where Black people can be found is a place called Solomon Islands. This place is way out in the Pacific Ocean on the other side of the world.

On August 2, 1943 at 2:30am, during World War II, a man named John F. Kennedy was in a small but fast boat. This kind of boat is called a PT boat. Kennedy was in the United State Navy and was in charge of the thirteen men who were with him. They were out looking for enemy warships.

It was so dark no one could see anything. Suddenly an enemy warship appeared. It hit Kennedy's boat and cut it in half. Kennedy and most of his men were badly hurt. They had to find a safe place to hide from the enemy. They found a hiding place on a small island called Plum Pudding Island. They hid there until they were found by two Black Solomon Island men. The two men were Eroni Kumana and Biuku Gasa. They took a message to the Navy. Kennedy and his men were saved.


After the war, Kennedy became the 35th President of the United States. If it had not been for the Black men of the Solomon Islands, Kennedy probably would never have become President.




BIBLE STUDY RESUMES ~ ONLINE AND IN-PERSON
