

#### YOUR 2024 MARCH RALLY DOLLARS AT WORK

Thanks to your generous support of our March Rally fundraiser, projects at Greater St. John have started or are in-progress, completed, or in the planning stage. These projects improve safety, upgrade older equipment or enhance appearances. Below are descriptions/photos of the major March Rally projects.





#### **COMPLETED PAINTING EXTERIOR DOORS:**

Wilco Distributing Co. replaced three of our exterior metal doors and frames (March Rally 2023). All 3 new exterior doors and frames plus one existing door and frame were painted this year by GNK Precision Painters.



#### **COMPLETED INTERIOR PAINTING:**

Patched and painted the vestibule outside of the sanctuary, hallway, sound Room ceilings. Painted walls outside the Gift Shop. Painted stairway walls and ceiling in Multi-Purpose Building. Painting completed by GNK Precision Painters.



# COMPLETED RELACING FLOURESCENT LIGHTS AND FIXTURES:

Replaced twenty-five 2'x4' LED fixtures and lights in the lower-level on the new side. Lights were purchased from US 31 Electrical Supply and installed by Art Jones.



#### **COMPLETED REPLACING WATER FOUNTAIN:**

Purchased two water fountains from Mid-City Supply Company. Brother James Fuller installed one fountain outside of the Sanctuary. The new fountain has a sanitary hands-free bottle filler, germ-free copper push pads to activate the water, and is designed to reduce waste water by 50%.



#### YOUR MARCH RALLY DOLLARS AT WORK



#### STARTED UPGRADE OF AUDIO/VIDEO EQUIPMENT:

In the sanctuary: organized and tied down wires and cables and removed 2 cameras from pedestals and mounted them to the ceiling. Replaced overhead projector in Multi-purpose building. Replaced Kitchen speaker, rewire TV monitors in the lower level, run wire for cable TV, in lower-level.

#### 2024 MARCH RALLY PROJECTS IN THE PLANNING STAGES:

- Recoat Baptism pool tub, repair handrail and tile floor.
- Paint lower-level dining area walls and columns on old side.
- Add lighting to lower-level women's restroom on new side.
- Repair/paint lower-level area walls, columns and ceiling on new side (*started July 3<sup>rd</sup>*).


